Christ Church of Jackson

Resolution Authorizing Mortgage of Real Estate

- Christ Church of Jackson (Christ Church) is in the planning phase of a Capital Improvement Plan to identify and execute much-needed projects to improve structures of all buildings associated with the Christ Church family.
 - Facilities and Finance teams worked together to develop a preliminary plan.
 - A cross-functional team will be formed to further identify and prioritize projects to be performed and to develop an implementation plan to be submitted to the Leadership Council for approval and further action.
- During the development of this preliminary plan, 4 key/critical projects were identified requiring immediate attention. A loan is needed, in the amount **not to exceed \$300,000**, for immediate resources to fund these critical items. Key/critical projects identified are as follows:
 - HVAC Replacement for FLC,
 - Stained Glass Window Refurbishment in the Sanctuary,
 - Restroom Renovations in the FLC, and
 - Flooring Replacement in the Mezzanine.
- The remaining approved Capital Improvement Plan projects will be performed as funds are made available by a new stewardship promotion to be “kicked off” during the summer of 2024.
- The Leadership Council is seeking the approval of a resolution by the Church Conference to authorize the Leadership Council to take all necessary steps, including the utilization of Christ Church-owned real estate as collateral, to secure a loan, in the amount **not to exceed \$300,000**, to provide immediate resources required to fund projects deemed to be key/critical to Christ Church.
