Pastor's Corner

- In times of trial and trouble, many commonly turn to the Bible for encouragement.
- On a scale of 1 to 100, with 100 being the most hopeful, Americans who report reading the Bible 3 or 4 times per year scored 42; people who read monthly scored 59; weekly, 66; and multiple times per week, 75.
- Bible reading—along with other forms of community and discipleship, such as going to church or participating in a small group—appear to contribute to people's sense of well-being and happiness
- What barriers might be preventing us from engaging more frequently with the Bible? More importantly, how can we overcome them?

Festival of Sharing

In August, our church is gathering flood buckets. Here is a list of the exact items needed:

- One five-gallon bucket with resealable lid
- 4-8oz. pump spray air freshener
- Scouring pads & Sponges
- Scrub brush (With or without handle)
- Reusable, lightweight multipurpose dry cleaning towels (No terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels)
- 32-64oz. or 25oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent
- 16-34oz. bottle of liquid disinfectant dish soap
- 12-40oz. bottle of liquid concentrate household cleaner that can be mixed with water (No spray bottles)
- Package of 36-50 clothespins
- 50-100ft. clothesline (Cotton or plastic line)
- Dust masks (N95 particulate respirator dust masks preferred)
- Heavy-duty, waterproof dishwashing gloves (Latex-free, non-surgical. Durable for multiple-use)
- Work gloves (Cotton with leather palm or all leather)
- 20-28 heavy-duty or contractor-type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll
- 6-9oz. bottle of non-aerosol insect repellent (Pump spray bottles must have protective covers. Packs of 10-20 insect repellent wipes also acceptable)
